#### PRE- MOVEMENT T.B. TESTING

As from Ist March 2007 all cattle aged 42 days and over are required to be T.B. Tested (and be negative) within 60 days of proposed movement if they are destined for further finishing (i.e. Store cattle at "Green Markets") provided you are in a parish of I or 2 years testing. If less frequent than this do not worry!

FINISHED CATTLE/OTM CATTLE at "Red Markets" (every Wednesday) there is no requirement for testing

#### FABBL – IMPORTANT

Even though you are selling Store Cattle, Buyers are very anxious that cattle MUST BE FARM ASSURED.

Please make every effort to get FABBL — it will be worthwhile.
