944 SHEEP SOLD

690 PRIME LAMBS & 254 CULL EWES & RAMS



690 PRIME LAMBS

A steady entry of near 700 lambs for the week between Christmas and the New Year. An overall similar SQQ to previous week but the better lambs selling well over the 200ppk mark.

Top of the day at 209ppk to a smart 45kg black Texel x from Master K Vigers of Simonsbath with 205ppk twice; the first to 44.5kg Suffolk x from Mr FC Reed & Son of North Molton and the second to 41.5kg Texel x from Messrs Roberts & Phillips of Dulverton. 204ppk four times; the first and second pens to 45kg & 45.7kg Suffolk x from Messrs Parsonage Farms of Chulmleigh; the third to 44.1kg Texel x from Messrs Irwin & Sons of Mariansleigh and the fourth to 46.5kg Charollais x from Mr BWJ Lavis of Okehampton. 203ppk twice; the first to 45.4kg Suffolk x from Messrs A & C Rowland of Bampton and the second to 45.3kg Suffolk x from Messrs J & J Watts of Goodleigh. 202ppk three times; the first to 42.3kg Charollais x from Messrs CP & CA Guscott of Dulverton; the second to 42kg Texel x from Messrs DL & JM Bray & Son of Knowstone and the third to 46kg Texel x from Mr R Irwin of Kings Nympton. 201ppk twice; the first to 43kg Texel x from Mrs M Tapp of Molland and the second to 41.6kg Suffolk x from Mr MWT Holmes of Kings Nympton. A further 7 pens exceeded the 200ppk mark.

A hat trick of £97.50 topped the lambs; the first and second pens to 55kg Charollais x and 52.5kg Texel x from Messrs Irwin & Sons of Mariansleigh with the third to 54.2kg Pure Texels from Mr G Dart & Sons of Molland. £96.80 to 54.5kg Texel x from Mr BWJ Lavis of Okehampton with £96.50 to similar bred 55.5kg lambs from Mrs M Tapp of Molland. £96 to 52kg Texel x from Mr R Irwin of

Kings Nympton with £95.20 to Messrs Irwin's third 5035kg pen of Texels. £95 three times; the first and second both to heavy Suffolk x pens from Messrs Parsonage Farms of Chulmleigh and the third to Mr Lavis' second pen of 46.5kg Charollais x. £94.50 to 53.6kg Texel x from Mr K Hill of Bideford with £94 twice; the first to 45kg black Texel x from Master K Vigers of Simonsbath and the second to 47kg Texel x from Messrs J & J Watts of Goodleigh.

254 CULL EWES & RAMS

A better show of cull sheep continued to follow a steady trade as seen on the previous few weeks with the overall average up £7 a head on the week. Best today at £94.50 to a super run of Suffolks from Messrs Cook Partners of Georgeham with £87 to further blackfaces from Messrs HJ & RH Mildon of Brayford. £84 three times; the first and second pens to Zwartbles and Suffolks from Messrs Cook with the third to Texels from Mr W Smale of North Molton. £77 twice; both to Suffolk pens from Messrs AD & SM Bray of Knowstone and the second to Mr Smale's second pen. £75 to Suffolks from Mr ME Snell & Son of Knowstone closely followed at £74.50 to further blackfaces from Mr Smale. £74 to Texels from Michael Bray of Knowstone with £73 to the Snell Family's second pen. Best rams rose to £100 for a grand Suffolk from Messrs HJ & RH Mildon of Brayford with £97.50 to another Suffolk from Messrs Parsonage Farms of Chulmleigh. A Lleyn from Messrs Britton of Barnstaple at £95.
