915 PRIME HOGGS, 242 CULL EWES & RAMS & 78 STORE LAMBS

915 PRIME HOGGS

Another solid entry of hoggs met an easier trade than the previous two weeks with probably not the quality of hoggs on offer as last week. The majority of the well-bred handy weight hoggs sold above the 190ppk mark. Lighter sorts again in demand but heavier types were sadly less money.

Top of the day at 201ppk to 36.5kg Texel crosses from Mr AW Fisher & Son of Oakford with 198ppk to 42.5kg black Texel crosses from Mr S Stentiford of South Molton. 196ppk to 39kg Suffolk crosses from Mr M Bray of Knowstone with 195ppk three times; the first and second pens to 39kg and 40kg Charollais crosses from Messrs MJ & AL Elston of Romansleigh with the third to 46kg Charollais cross from Miss S Stentiford of South Molton. 194ppk three times; the first to 39kg Suffolk crosses from Mr G Dart & Sons of Molland; the second to 40.2kg Charollais crosses from Mr KW Baker of Poughill and the third to 42.6kg Texel crosses from Mr NA Cooke of Torrington. 193ppk twice; the first to 45.1kg Texel crosses from Mr W Smale of North Molton and the second to 46.4kg Texel crosses from Messrs Cook Partners of Georgeham. 192ppk six times all to handyweight continental and Suffolk crosses from Mr KW Baker (second pen), Mr S Stentiford (second pen), Mr G Webster of Umberleigh, Mr BR Head of Oakford, Mr EJ Westaway of Newton Tracey and Mrs M Tapp of South Molton.

Best today at £101 to grand 71kg Suffolk crosses from Messrs Parsonage Farms of Chulmleigh with £95.50 to 65kg Suffolk crosses from Mr RD Middleton & Son of Ashreigney. £94.20 to 64kg Texel crosses from Messrs FG & FM Saunders of Templeton with £93.50 to 58kg Charollais crosses from Messrs Cook Partners of Georgeham. £92 to 52kg Charollais crosses from Mr S Stentiford of South Molton with £91.20 to 49kg Texel crosses from Mr W Smale of North closely followed at £91 to 50.8kg Suffolk crosses from the same vendor.

£91 also achieved a further four times; the first to 49.5kg Charollais crosses from Mr KW Baker of Poughill; the second to 52.5kg Charollais crosses from Messrs WJ & MA Stoneman of Chulmleigh; the third to 55kg Charollais crosses from Mr WJ Woollacott & Sons of Bishops Nympton and the fourth to 56kg Berrichon crosses from Mr MW Pearce of Harracott.

242 CULL EWES & RAMS

Another small entry of cull sheep sold to a very similar trade to previous weeks. Unfortunately very few best ewes forward and a large number of plainer, smaller ewes kept the overall average down. Topping the ewes at £108 to a pen of Pure Texels from Messrs AJ & MJ Tarr & Son of West Anstey with £92.50 also to Texels from Mrs M Tapp of South Molton. £77 to Suffolks from Messrs FG & FM Saunders of Templeton closely followed at £76.50 to Texel crosses from Mr L Gillbard & Son of Black Dog. £76 twice; the first to Suffolks from Mr J Cowle of Winkleigh and the second to Messrs AJ & MJ Tarr & Son's second pen. £75.50 to Charollais' from Messrs TE & J Middleton & Son of Ashreigney with £75 to Suffolks from Messrs Cook Partners of Georgeham. £73.50 to Suffolks from Mr G Dart & Sons of Molland with £72 twice; the first to Messrs Cook's second pens and the second to Dorsets from Mr RP Gammack of Kings Nympton. Topping the rams at £99 to a grand Blue Faced Leicester from Mr B Nicholls of Barnstaple with £89 to a Suffolk from Mr M Bray of Knowstone.

Best today at £74 to Charollais crosses from Messrs Tucker & Son of Barnstaple with £67.50 to Texel crosses from Mr DP Barthram of Rackenford. £63.50 to Charollais crosses from Mr RJ Radford of Mariansleigh with £62 to Texel crosses from Mr MB Short of Kings Nympton.
