PRE-MOVEMENT T.B. TESTING

As from 1st March 2007 all cattle aged 42 days and over are required to be T.B. Tested (and be negative) within 60 days of proposed movement if they are destined for further finishing (i.e. Store cattle at "Green Markets") provided you are in a parish of 1 or 2 years testing. If less frequent than this do not worry!

FINISHED CATTLE/OTM CATTLE at "Red Markets" (every Wednesday) there is no requirement for testing

FABBL - IMPORTANT

Even though you are selling Store Cattle, Buyers are very anxious that cattle MUST BE FARM ASSURED. Please make every effort to get FABBL – it will be worthwhile.

STORE SHEEP - 410

Considering the time of year & the uncertainty surrounding the fat trade we experienced an absolutely blistering trade from the very first pen right until the very last pen. From the offset an army of buyers were prepared to compete for all pens.

Biggest Hoggs ranged between £70-£75, with Farming Hoggs £66-£70.

Overall average £60.45 which included a large number of smaller, plainer Hoggs.

EWES & LAMBS - 19

Still no great numbers of couples forward but, those that were present sold to a solid trade.
