### 1311 SHEEP SOLD

**833 PRIME HOGGS & LAMBS & 478 CULL EWES & RAMS**

#### 833 PRIME HOGGS & LAMBS

A larger entry of hogs met another increase trade for the lighter and medium weights, with the majority of the pens around the 200ppk mark. Heavier hogs between 47-50kgs again dearer however the super heavies still meeting very little demand.

208ppk topped the hogs twice; the first to 42.8kg Charollais crosses from Messrs Irwin & Sons of Mariansleigh and the second to 43kg Charollais crosses from Mr AR Bater of Chittlehamholt. 207ppk to 42kg Charollais crosses from Messrs J & H Searle of Ash Mill with 206ppk to 41.2kg Texel crosses (NFA) from Messrs A & C Curtis of Templeton. 205ppk to 44.1kg Charollais crosses from Mr MB Short of Burrington with 204ppk three times; the first and second pens to 41.2kg and 42.1kg Charollais crosses from Messrs GF & PJ Warne of Umberleigh with the third pen to 4038kg Charollais crosses from Mr MW Pearce of Harracott. 203ppk three times; the first to 38kg Texel crosses from Mr RJ Charlton of Nomansland; the second to 42.7kg Texel crosses from Mr NA Cooke of Torrington and the third to Mr Bater's second pens of 44.4kg Suffolk crosses. 202ppk twice; the first to Messrs Irwin's second pen of 45kg Charollais crosses and the second Messrs Searle's second pen of 45.8kg Charollais crosses. 201ppk also achieved twice; the first to Messrs Irwin's third similar weight pen and the second to 42.8kg Charollais crosses from Mr J Cowle of Winkleigh.

Best today at £93 to 65kg Charollais crosses from Messrs RJ & KJ Cole of Ashreigney with £92.50 twice; the first to 45.8kg Charollais crosses from Messrs J & H Searle of Ash Mill and the second to 65kg Suffolk crosses from Mr SRJ Snell of Ashreigney. £92 four times; the first to 48.1kg Texel crosses from Mr DJ Woollacott of South Molton; the second to 49.5kg Suffolk crosses from Mr AR Bater of Chittlehamholt; the third to 48.4kg Charollais crosses from Messrs GF & PJ Warne of Umberleigh and the fourth to 49kg Charollais crosses from Mr EJ Westaway of Newton Tracey. £90.80 three times; the first to 45kg Charollais crosses from Messrs Irwin & Sons of Mariansleigh; the second to 47.6kg Charollais crosses from Mr EF Thorne of Tawstock and the third to Mr Snell's second pen of 46kg Texel

crosses. Another hat-trick at £90.50; the first to 46.5kg Suffolk crosses from Messrs A & C Rowland of Bampton; the second to 47.6kg Suffolk crosses from Mr KB Reed of Nomansland and the third to Messrs Irwin & Sons' second pen of 45kg Charollais crosses. £90.20 to 44.1kg Charollais crosses from Mr MB Short of Burrington with a further 10 pens going under the hammer at £90.

A handful of new season lambs rose to 210ppk (£81) to 38.5kg Dorset crosses from Miss P Wyatt of Lynton

#### 478 CULL EWES & RAMS

Another larger entry of cull sheep which met a similar trade to last week although higher proportion of small ewes brought the overall average down but across the board all types were wanted and met demand. Top of the day at £131 to a grand Pure Texel from Mr DW Ridd of West Buckland with further Pure Texels from Mr NA Cooke of Torrington rose to £117.50. Charollais' from Mr CF Rice rose to £102 whilst Suffolk Mules from Messrs MJ & DM Lake rang the bell at £99, the same money as other Pure Texels from Mr Ridd's second pen. £94.50 to Texel crosses from Mr ACH Perryman of Black Dog closely followed at £94 twice; the first to Suffolk Mules from Mr T Elliott of Newton St Petrock and the second to Mr Ridd's third pen of this time Suffolks. £91 & £90 to Mr Rice's second and third pen of Charollais' with £90 realised a further two times; the first to Suffolk Mules from Messrs IFJ & JC Harris of Beaworthy and the second to Suffolk Mules from Messrs AW & SA Meikle of Meshaw.

A few more rams about this week topped at £93 for a pair of Texels from Mr WB Manley & Son of Hemyock with £91.50 to another pair of Texels from Mr ME Snell & Son of Knowstone.
