The trade on the Hoggetts followed the stagnant trade of Monday with heavy hogs difficult to place. There was however a distinct premium for the best end of the handy weight hogs and the lighter weights. We hope the trade will stick it through the spring for hogs of all types. Follow our predictions through the week via social media and the website and we hope for another large entry next week. The SQQ average of £1.95ppk and the overall average of £1.90ppk reflects the effect on trade of the number of hogs outside the desired weight spec.
