PRE-MOVEMENT T.B. TESTING

As from 1st March 2007 all cattle aged 42 days and over are required to be T.B. Tested (and be negative) within 60 days of proposed movement if they are destined for further finishing (i.e. Store cattle at "Green Markets") provided you are in a parish of 1 or 2 years testing. If less frequent than this do not worry! FINISHED CATTLE/OTM CATTLE at "Red Markets" (every Wednesday) there is no requirement for testing

FABBL - IMPORTANT

Even though you are selling Store Cattle, Buyers are very anxious that cattle MUST BE FARM ASSURED. Please make every effort to get FABBL - it will be worthwhile.

WEANLINGS - 10

A "cracking" bunch of weanlings on offer, selling to an equally fantastic trade with plenty of buyers looking to purchase. British Blue X Steer Weanlings selling up to £465 with overall average £383, Heifers averaging £366 for a mix of British Blue X & Aberdeen Angus X.

STORE SHEEP - 38

Another end of season entry, still sold to a flying trade for the time of year, with plenty of competition. Best Hogs up to £72, averaging £66.11

EWES & LAMBS - 112
