1420 PRIME HOGGS, 244 PRIME LAMBS & 397 CULL EWES & RAMS

1420 PRIME LAMBS

An excellent entry of new season lambs, well up on last week and with a dearer trade. Buyers have been requesting lighter lambs and farmers today obliged with a cracking entry of quality lambs from start to finish. Trade for the 42-44kg lambs was definitely stronger than previous weeks with the lambs getting dearer as the sale progressed, the dearest lambs of the day being seen at the end which is unusual seeing the large number forward. Top of the day at £106.50 to 45.7kg Suffolk and Charollais crosses from Mr G Mills & Partners Ltd of Witheridge, the last pen sold of another super run of lambs from the Mills Family. £106.20 to 41.8kg Texel crosses from Mr MJ King & Sons of Iddesleigh with £105.50 to 42kg Charollais crosses from Messrs D & J Baker of Yarnscombe. £105.20 twice; all to 42.8-9kg Suffolk pens from Messrs Parsonage Farms of Chulmleigh, who also sold a super run of Suffolk sired lambs. £105 five times; the first to third pens to 42-43kg Suffolk crosses again from Messrs Parsonage Farms; the fourth to 40.3kg Suffolk crosses from Mr RH Dymond & Son of Croyde and the fifth to 41.9kg Suffolk crosses again from the Mills Family. £104.80 twice; both to further Suffolk sired pens from Messrs Parsonage Farms and the Mills Family. £104.50 again rang the bell five times; the first and second from Parsonage Farms; the third from the Mills Family; the fourth to 40.2kg Charollais crosses from Mr J Norman of Shirwell and the fifth to 46.5kg Texel crosses from Mr JA Cockwill of Yarnscombe.

Best pens to 263ppk to 39.4kg Charollais crosses from Messrs D & J Baker of Yarnscombe with 261ppk to 40.3kg Suffolk crosses from Mr RH Dymond & Son of Croyde. 260ppk to 40.2kg Charollais crosses from Mr J Norman of Shirwell with 258ppk twice; the first to 40.2kg Texel crosses from Messrs HJ & RH Mildon of Brayford and the second to Mr Norman's second pen of 39.8kg Charollais'. 257ppk three times; all to 39-40kg Texel crosses from Messrs DW & AE Enticott of Ashbrittle with 256ppk also a hat-trick; the first to 40kg Texel crosses from Messrs DJ & SL Kittow of Witleigh and the second and third to further handyweight pens from the Enticott Family. 255ppk twice; the first to 40kg Charollais crosses from Mr WJ Woollacott & Sons of Bishops Nympton and the second to a further pen from the Enticott Family. 254ppk to 41.8kg Texel crosses from Mr MJ King & Sons of Iddesleigh and 253kkg to 41kg Charollais crosses from Mr DEJ Nott of Kennerleigh.

244 PRIME HOGGS

A smaller show of hoggs as they begin to "dry up" but a definite upturn in trade. A very mixed entry as can be expected at this time of year however most weights would have been a touch dearer. Top to £97.50 twice; both to 49.6kg and 65.6kg Texel crosses from Messrs Beer Brothers of Warkleigh. £96.20 to 53kg Charollais crosses from Mr MTD Pile of Dunkswell with £95.80 to 49.5kg Charollais crosses from Mr CR Mildon of Bishops Nympton. £95.20 twice; the first to 48.5kg Suffolk crosses from Mr FC Reed of North Molton and the second to 44.5kg Texel crosses from Messrs D & J Baker of Yarnscombe. £95 three times; the first to 46kg Texel crosses from Mr R Richards of Heasley Mill; the second to 80kg Charollais crosses from Mr AE Chudley & Son of Romansleigh and the third to 69kg Suffolk from Messrs RT & HD Kingdon of Barnstaple. Best pens to 214ppk to 44.5kg Texel crosses from Messrs D & J Baker of Yarnscombe with 212ppk to 40kg Charollais crosses from Messrs B & T Baker of Alverdiscott. 207ppk to 46kg Texel crosses from Mr R Richards of Heasley Mill with 206ppk three times; the first to 45.7kg Suffolk crosses from Messrs A & C Rowland of Bampton; the second to 42.8kg Texel crosses from Mr S Bale of Challacombe and the third to 43.5kg Charollais crosses from Messrs D & J Baker again.

397 CULL EWES & RAMS

A smaller entry of cull sheep this week after the last two weeks big numbers. As expected trade was less following lower prices across the country this week. Ramadan is now in full flow and will continue to the end of the month which will reduce sales. Topping the day at £119 for a strong pen of Pure Texels from Mr DW Ridd of West Buckland with £97 to a super ring full of Suffolk Mules from Mr RF Jones of Heasley Mill. £89 to another super run of Suffolk Mules, this time from Mr WJ Woollacott & Sons of Bishops Nympton closely followed at £88.50 to further blackfaces from Mr DJ Govier & Partners of Chulmleigh. £87.50 to Mr Jones' second pen of Suffolks closely followed at £87 to Texels from Mr FR Chave & Son of Cruwys Morchard. £85 to Suffolk Mules from Mr WB Manley & Son of Hemyock with £84.50 to further similar bred ewes from Mr N Duncum of Burrington. £84 twice; the first to Mr Manley's second pen and the second to further Suffolks from Messrs HJ & RH Mildon of Brayford. £83 to Suffolks from Messrs G & P Kivell of Ashreigney with £82.50 to Mr Jone's third pen. Best rams to £94.50 to a pair of Texels from Mr FC Reed of North Molton with another three Texels from Mr AR Hobbs of Barnstaple at £89.50.
