Tested (and be negative) **within 60 days** of proposed movement if they are destined for further finishing (i.e. Store cattle at "Green Markets") provided you are in a parish of 1 or 2 years testing. If less frequent than this do not worry!*

*FINISHED CATTLE/OTM CATTLE at "Red Markets" (every Wednesday) there is no requirement for testing*

## **FABBL - IMPORTANT**

*Even though you are selling Store Cattle,  
Buyers are very anxious that cattle MUST BE FARM ASSURED.  
Please make every effort to get FABBL - it will be worthwhile.*
