PRE-MOVEMENT T.B. TESTING

<u>As from 1st March 2007 all cattle aged 42 days and over</u> are required to be T.B. Tested (and be negative) <u>within 60 days</u> of proposed movement if they are destined for further finishing (i.e. Store cattle at "Green Markets") provided you are in a parish of 1 or 2 years testing. If less frequent than this do not worry!

FINISHED CATTLE/OTM CATTLE at "Red Markets" (every Wednesday) there is no requirement for testing

FABBL - IMPORTANT

Even though you are selling Store Cattle, Buyers are very anxious that cattle MUST BE FARM ASSURED. Please make every effort to get FABBL – it will be worthwhile.
