260 SPRING LAMBS

A disappointing show of spring lambs in terms of numbers with a corresponding lack of top quality lambs within the entry. The lambs were again forward from a large geographical area and we were lucky of the Vendors travelling from furthest afield. The trade was consistent to the previous day's trading for the better end with smalls up on the day and the week. The best lambs sold to £2.28ppk AE Jones, Coedmorehall and £97.20 from PG Amphlett, Tawelfa.

We again reiterate the need for larger springer entries every week going forward to meet buyer demand.

200 CULL SHEEP

Where normally two rows of old ewes would be pleasing; the recent trend in entries of up to 450 cull sheep has raised expectations especially in the run up to Ramadan and especially last week. The trade was back to an even better trade than the previous weeks for all classes and categories. The entry again suited the trade in terms of strength and cover with only a few over fat ewes forward. The leaner ewes of all types were again the dearest pound for pound on the day reaching an even better trade than last week for this type of half meated ewe. The overall average of £68 is up £10 on last week per head for a much smaller show. A much larger entry is required next week.
