**1163 PRIME LAMBS, 27 PRIME HOGGS, 352 CULL EWES & RAMS**

**1163 PRIME LAMBS**

Another shorter entry of new season lambs than of previous weeks as the weather begins to brighten up and many farmers have grass to cut. A lesser quality entry with more leaner lambs on offer however the overall trade was up 4-5ppk on last week. The 44-46kg lambs are the most sought after and the lighter leaner lambs becoming the hardest to sell. A shortage of bugger heavier lambs means they were also well sought after. Top of the day at £109.50 to 56kg Texel crosses from Mr CJ Thorne of South Molton with £107.50 to 53kg Texel crosses from Master HJ Dart of Bishops Nympton. £103 to 51kg Charollais crosses from Mr G Dart & Sons of Molland with £102 to 50kg Charollais crosses from Messrs WJ & MA Stoneman of Chulmleigh. £101 to 52kg Texel crosses from Messrs J & J Watts of Goodleigh with £100 three times; the first to 49kg Charollais crosses from Mr WM Folland of Roborough; the second to 48.2kg Suffolk crosses from Mr G Webster of Umberleigh and the third to 54kg Dorset crosses from Mr EO Ayre of North Molton. £99.50 to 47.6kg Texel crosses from Messrs PF & PA Tucker of High Bickington closely followed at £99 to 47.3kg Suffolk crosses again from Messrs Watts. £98.20 to 46kg Charollais crosses from Mr NJ Sharland of Braunton with £97.50 to 45.5kg Texel crosses from Mr NA Cooke of Torrington.

Best pens to 215ppk five times; the first to 44kg Texel crosses from Messrs D & L Folland of Barnstaple; the second to 43.3kg Suffolk crosses from Messrs CJ & LM Hill of Yarnscombe; the third to 43kg Suffolk crosses from Messrs Govier & Son of South Molton; the fourth to 45kg Suffolk crosses from Mr NJ Sharland of Braunton and the fifth to 39.7kg Charollais crosses from Messrs B & T Baker of Alverdiscott. 214ppk four times; the first to 45.5kg Texel crosses from Mr NA Cooke of Torrington; the second to 43.6kg Charollais and Suffolk crosses from Messrs RJ & GM Tucker of High Bickington; the third to 44kg Dorset crosses from Messrs Govier's second pen and the fourth to 44kg Charollais crosses from Mrs PA Stentiford of Whiddon. 213ppk also achieved four times; the first to 44.2kg Suffolk crosses from Mr G Webster of Umberleigh; the second to 44.2kg Charollais crosses from Mr R Irwin of Kings

Nympton; the third to 42.2kg Charollais crosses from Messrs L & SM Govier also of Kings Nympton and the fourth to 46kg Charollais crosses again from Mr Sharland. 212ppk seven times; the first to 43.8kg Charollais crosses again from Messrs Govier; the second to 40.1kg Charollais crosses from Messrs J & H Searle of Ash Mill; the third to 41.2kg Charollais crosses again from Messrs Baker; the fourth to 45.5kg Suffolk crosses from Mr RAP Grant of Cruwys Morchard; the fifth to 42.8kg Suffolk crosses from Mr B Beel of Umberleigh; the sixth to 43.4kg Charollais crosses from Mr MJ Selley of South Molton and the seventh to 44.6kg Charollais crosses again from Mr R Irwin.

**352 CULL EWES, RAMS & MATURE SHEEP**

A smaller entry of cull sheep which consisted of all shapes and sizes! Trade was definitely sharper with all ewes dearer by around £3-5 per head on the week. A number of smaller ewes forward which were generally all £40 plus and nice to get the Suffolk Mules back over the £90 mark this week. Top of the day at £98 for a Pure Suffolk from Master HJ Dart of Bishops Nympton with Suffolk Mules from Mr DJ Woollacott of South Molton at £93. £86 twice; the first to Texel crosses from Messrs JB & MA Turner of Harracott and the second to Suffolk Mules from Messrs G Heywood & Son of Buckland Brewer. £83 to Suffolk Mules from Messrs Govier & Son of South Molton with £81 to further blackfaces from Messrs Turner. Messrs Turner also sold other Suffolks to £80.50, the same money at Texel crosses from Mr MJ Selley of South Molton. £80 to Texel crosses from Messrs Bendle & Lintin of Chittlehampton with £79.50 twice; both to Suffolk Mule pens from Messrs J & J Watts of Goodleigh and Messrs CJ & LM Hill of Yarnscombe. £79 three times; the first to Texel crosses from Mr AE Chudley & Son of Romansleigh; the second to Suffolk Mules from Mr J Edwards of Yarnscombe and the third to Suffolk crosses from Messrs MG & SR Kingdon of Swimbridge. £78.50 to Dorsets from Messrs SD & EM Ellam of Rackenford with £78 to further Suffolk Mules from Mr DJ Woollacott. Best rams to £93 for a pair of Texels from Messrs MG & SR Kingdon of Swimbridge with another Texel from Mr MW Pearce of Harracott at £80.
