The lambs were again forward from a large geographical area including new Vendors travelling from far afield. The trade was difficult from start to finish with Purchasers switched off and Vendors not keen to taking another Tuesday drop in price. We will watch this week's trend in trading with interest. The best lambs sold to £2.15ppk PJ+TA Jones, Tyisaf and M/s Brute, Gwndwnwal and £98.80 from WTL Walters, Lower Pontgwylim.

The entry again suited the trade in terms of strength and cover. There were over fat ewes forward but these were sold to a solid trade. The leaner ewes of all types were again the dearest pound for pound on the day reaching an even better trade than last week for this type of half meated ewe. The overall average of £72 reflects the strength of the trade for the quality entry. A similar large entry is required next week.
