1388 PRIME LAMBS & 331 CULL EWES & RAMS

1388 PRIME LAMBS

A larger entry of lambs for the week prior to the Qurbani Festival sold to a much stronger trade. Those farmers that have kept lambs back from the early lambing were well rewarded with the overall average of the Qurbani lambs with signed declarations averaging over the 200ppk mark. Trade for the Qurbani lambs was strong from start to finish which helped to the lift the trade for the later born lambs that got dearer as the sale went on. The festival starts next week and with a larger amount of lambs sold over the past two week nationally it is exceptionally difficult to predict where the trade will be next week. Top of the day at £110 for 70kg Pure Suffolk from Mr R Irwin of Kings Nympton with £101.50 to 55kg Texel crosses from Mr AJ Dart of Chulmleigh. £99 three times; the first to 54.3kg Charollais crosses from Messrs DJ & RA Woollacott of Yarnscombe; the second to 49.2kg Suffolk crosses from Messrs Milborne Wick Farms Ltd of Sherborne and the third to 50kg Texel crosses from Messrs S & J Bale of Challacombe. £98 twice; the first to 49.7kg Charollais crosses from Mr DG Barrow of Molland and the second to 48.3kg Texel crosses from Mr M Dallyn of South Molton. £97.50 to 51.4kg Texel crosses from Messrs RJ & SA Rowe of Simonsbath with £97.20 twice; the first to 47kg Suffolk crosses from Mr R Treniman of Ashreigney and the second to Messrs Rowe's second 49.6kg Texel cross pen. £97 five times; the first and second to 45kg and 46kg Charollais crosses from Messrs M & A Holland of Barnstaple; the third to 47.7kg Texel crosses from Mr FJ Sing of Mariansleigh; the fourth to 47kg Black Texel crosses from Messrs SM & EM Reed of Umberleigh and the fifth to 50.5kg Suffolk crosses from Mr GC Thomas of Burrington. £96.80 to 48.4kg Charollais crosses again from Messrs Woollacott with £96.50 to 51kg Charollais crosses from Mr PV Leworthy of Barnstaple.

Best pens to 211ppk twice to 45kg and 46kg Charollais crosses from Messrs M & A Holland of Barnstaple with 209ppk to 45kg Charollais crosses from Mr R Treniman of Ashreigney. 208ppk twice; the first to 43.2kg Texel crosses from Mr GJ Hookway of Ilfracombe and the second to 46kg Suffolk crosses from Mr KB Reed of Nomansland. 207ppk three

times; the first to Mr Hookway's Texel cross pen; the second to 44.8kg Pure Texels from Messrs SM & EM Reed of Umberleigh and the third to 47kg Suffolk crosses again from Mr Treniman. 206ppk twice; the first to 40kg Dorset crosses from Messrs IR & JM Prouse of Holsworthy and second to Messrs Reed's second pen of Texel crosses. 205ppk twice; the first to 47kg Blue Texel from Mr R Irwin of Kings Nympton and the second to Messrs's Prouse's second 43.4kg pen. A hat trick at 204ppk; the first to 44kg Suffolk crosses from Mr AJ Basset of Iddesleigh; the second to 44.6kg Charollais crosses from Messrs GJ & SM Down of High Bickington and the third to Mr Treniman's third pen. 203ppk four times; the first to 43.9kg Texel crosses from Messrs RJ & J Ridd of East Buckland; the second to 44kg Texel crosses from Messrs S & J Bale of Challacombe; the third to 48.3kg Texel crosses from Mr M Dallyn of South Molton and the fourth to 47.7kg Texel crosses from Mr FJ Sing of Mariansleigh.

331 CULL EWES & RAMS

A smaller entry of cull sheep as other markets throughout the week have been reporting a down turn in trade. The shorter number certainly helped and trade was actually very similar to last week. Again the leaner, smaller ewes were hardest to place with plenty of demand for the well fleshed, bigger ewes. Top of the day at £127.50 for a pair of grand Pure Texels from Messrs SM & EM Reed of Umberleigh. £96 to Texels from Messrs IP & L Stagg of Barnstaple with £95 to a Blue Texel from Miss J Maynard of Thelbridge. £90.50 to Texel crosses from Messrs G & TA Nicholas of Marwood with £89 to Texel Mules from Messrs TH & PM Bolt of Huntsham. Closely followed at £88.50 to Suffolk Mules from Messrs TJ & L Gould of West Anstey with £85 and £84.50 to two Texel cross pens from Messrs M & L Gillbard of Morchard Bishop. The same money at Suffolk Mules from Mr R Richard of Heasley Mill. £84 to blackfaces from Mr MD Parkin of Ilfracombe with £82.50 to further Suffolk crosses from Messrs DL & JM Bray & Son of Knowstone. £81.50 to Mr Richards second pen of Suffolks with Messrs Nicholas' second pen of similar bred ewes rising to £81. Best rams to £109 for a pair of Blue Texels from Miss J Maynard of Thelbridge with three Texels from Messrs Scott Partners of Brompton Regis at £101.
