400 SPRING LAMBS

A disappointing show of lambs in terms of numbers especially following the flying trade of last week which saw Brecon top of the local and national leagues. There was however a top quality show throughout with lambs of serious finish and conformation. The general run of the trade was well back on the flyer of the previous week; but a total clearance was eventually managed. The better end of the lambs were however a real trade and sold to a marked premium. The best lambs sold to £2ppk (£98) M/s Brute, Gwndwnwal and £2/Kg (£91) from M/s Jones, Tyisaf. We again reiterate the need for larger lamb entries every week going forward to meet buyer demand.

The nicer meated ewes of all types were again the dearest pound for pound. There weren't the top quality pedigree ewes forward to top the trade but those crossbred ewes sold in the 90's again looked a serious trade. It is difficult to comprehend why the yard isn't full of cull sheep and improved Vendor support and a much larger entry is required in the coming weeks.
