1179 PRIME LAMBS & 444 CULL EWES & RAMS

1179 PRIME LAMBS

Another decent entry of lambs this week and a marked improvement in the trade despite being a buyer down. Best trade was for the stronger well fleshed lambs with all buyers present keen to secure the better lambs. Many pens sold over the 180ppk mark with the medium lambs generally 2ppk dearer on the week. However the lighter leaner lambs still remain difficult to sell around the 160ppk mark. Top of the day at £112 to a pair of 66kg Pure Suffolk ram lambs from Mr LW Reed of Nomansland with £111 to 61kg Berrichon from Mr J Yeo of Georgeham. Following the pattern at £110 was a 60kg Suffolk from Mr FC Reed of North Molton with a further pen of 58kg Suffolks from Mr LW Reed at £103. £99.50 to 57kg Charollais crosses from Mr MJ Milton of Atherington with £93.50 twice; the first to 51.5kg Suffolk crosses from Messrs JC & ME Barnes & Son of North Buckland and the second to 50kg Charollais crosses from Mrs FE Tucker of South Molton. £92 to 49.3kg Charollais crosses from Messrs RJ & GM Tucker of High Bickington with £90.20 to 50.2kg Suffolk crosses again from Mr LW Reed. £90 five times; the first to 52kg Charollais crosses from Mr DJ Govier & Partners of Chulmleigh; the second to 48kg Texel crosses from Mr NJ Sharland of Branton; the third to 48.2kg Charollais crosses from Messrs Tucker again; the fourth to 50.7kg Blue Faced Leicester from Mr Yeo again and the fifth to 49.6kg Charollais crosses from Mr MJ Avery of Yarnscombe.

Best pens to 195ppk to 46kg Charollais crosses from Mrs PA Stentiford of Barnstaple with two pens at 189ppk; the first to 45kg Texel crosses from Mrs CT Jones of South Molton and the second to 45kg Cheviot from Mr KB Reed of Nomansland. 188ppk three times; the first to 44.4kg Texel crosses from Mr GD Fuller & Son of Chulmleigh; the second to 48kg Charollais crosses from Mr NJ Sharland of Branton and the third to Mrs Stentiford's second 46kg pen. 187ppk five times; the first to Mrs Jones' second 44.6kg pen; the second and third pens to 49.3kg Suffolk

crosses and 48.3kg Charollais crosses from Messrs RJ & GM Tucker of High Bickington; the fourth to 46kg Suffolk crosses from Mr DJ Govier & Partners of Chulmleigh and the fifth to 50kg Charollais crosses from Mrs FE Tucker of South Molton. 186ppk to 43.8kg Charollais crosses from Mr SM Maddick of East Anstey with 185ppk twice; the first to 41kg Berrichon from Mr J Yeo of Georgeham and the second to 44.3kg Charollais crosses from Messrs KW, MJ & JP Moore of Newton Tracey. 184ppk twice also; the first to 47kg Texel crosses from Messrs S & J Bale of Challacombe and the second to 47.8kg Charollais crosses from Messrs L & SM Govier of Kings Nympton.

444 CULL EWES & RAMS

A strong number of cull sheep which consisted of large number of hill bred and very lean ewes ultimately bringing down the average. Trade overall was very similar to last week with the best ewes the same money but a few new faces on the grazing ewes making them £4-5 per head dearer. Topping the day at £98.50 for a pen of Pure Texels from Mr FC Reed of North Molton with Suffolk Mules from Messrs AD & SM Bray of Knowstone at £82.50. £81.50 twice; both to Texel cross pens from Messrs G & TA Nicholas of Marwood and Messrs M & L Gillbard of Morchard Bishop. £81 to Suffolks from Mr FC Reed of North Molton with £79 twice; the first to Suffolk Mules from Mr Reed this time and the second to Charollais from Mr P Barker of Chulmleigh. £78.50 twice; the first to Suffolk Mules from Mr RJ Cole of Knowstone and the second to Messrs Nicholas' second Texel cross pen. £78 twice again; the first to Texels from Messrs Gillbard and the second to Suffolk Mules from Messrs Nicholas. £76 to Texels from Mr FR Chave & Son of Cruwys Morchard with further Texels from Mr J Yeo of Georgeham at £75. Best rams to £97 for a Suffolk from Mr G Dart & Sons of Molland whose second Charollais rose to £94.

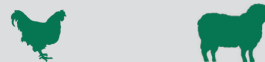
