CALVES & WEANLINGS

A good entry of well reared weaned calves consigned for the first sale of the year met a flying trade for all breeds.

A smart weaned Hereford bull topped the trade at £525 and a steer to £450.

Well grown sorts reached £505 for a British Blue x bull (6 months) and a Fleckveigh bull to £345 for the same age. Heifers from the same consignment settled at £410 for British Blue Heifers and Angus heifers to £325.

Stronger Angus x weaned bulls (6 months) to £440 and £345 for heifers the same age.

Dairy bred sorts also in high demand with Montbeliarde bulls (4 months) to £360, £270 and £245. Friesian bulls (6 months) from the same consignment to £270.

Plenty more could have been sold to a strong trade.

STORE HOGGETS – 2,100

A good entry of store hoggets sold to an exceptional trade to a large crowd of buyers. The lift in the fat hogget trade over the Christmas period coupled with the expectation of a shorter supply of fat hoggets in the spring is fuelling the store hogget trade.

The whole store hogget section averaged a fabulous £75.15 per head up to £96 per head.

Strong hoggets sold from £80 to £96 per head.

Medium hoggets sold from £68 to £78 per head.

Small hoggets sold from £55 to £65 per head.

Mini hoggets sold from £30 to £45 per head.
