COUNTRYSIDE STEWARDSHIP SCHEME

APPLICATION WINDOW NOW OPEN – BE PREPARED AND ACT EARLY

The Countryside Stewardship Mid-Tier, Water Capital Grants and Hedgerow and Boundary Grants
are now open for applications.

MID TIER / WATER CAPITAL GRANTS

Mid-Tier: A five-year agreement for field options such as low input grassland, buffer strips on
arable land and planting bird food and flower mixes.

Water Capital Grants: A two-year agreement for capital items such as concreting of farmyards,
roofing over livestock handling areas, fencing, sprayer wash down areas and rainwater goods. This
can be included within a Mid-Tier application (no maximum) or as a standalone agreement
(£10,000 maximum).

Application packs have to be ordered by 31st May 2020.

For Water Capital Grant Items – Catchment Sensitive Farming Officer approval is required and
need to be requested by 31st May 2020.

Applications need to be submitted by 31st July 2020.

Successful offers will have an agreement start date of 1st January 2021.

HEDGEROW AND BOUNDARY GRANTS

Applications close 1st May 2020.

Maximum Grant for £10,000 for a two-year agreement to carry out works such as Hedgerow
Laying, Hedgerow Coppicing, Hedgerow Gapping Up, Stone Wall and Earth Bank Restoration.
Fencing is required both sides, but no grant available under this option. However, fencing grant is
available under a Mid-Tier agreement.

Successful offers will be sent out from July 2020 onwards.
