A better show of hoggetts on the week in terms of numbers forward and a similar quality show. The trade was up on the week for all classes with a marked increase in returns for the best lambs. Numbers are generally short and it is this restriction on supply that continues to positively influence trade. It is reiterated that this lack of supply is a risk with numbers consistently required to maintain the demand that the buyers at Brecon provide on a weekly basis. It is reiterated that far more lambs are needed every week.

250 CULL SHEEP

A better entry of cull sheep this week but still short on our weekly requirement. We thought the trade last week was on fire but this week it was even better again. The highlight last week was a pen of Welsh Ewes from Carregcynffordd at £110 which we thought was a breed centre record. This was surpassed this week by £117 for similar types from Davies, Pencaenewydd. The trade at Brecon is consistently ahead of other local competing centres and those further afield with ewes travelling a long way to be sold at our centre. We are still short every week of ewes of all categories and even more are needed to meet demand. Similar large entries of well covered and plain ewes are required in the ensuing weeks.
