To the best of my knowledge all the animals comply with the **The Sheep & Goats (Records, Identification and Movement) (England) Order 2009** All home bred sheep born after 1st February 2003 must be tagged under hygiene regulations, any sheep slaughtered without a tag may not enter the human food chain, any sheep brought to Honiton without an ear tag will not be offered for sale. Any lambs or cull ewes sold for slaughter which lose their tag, if direct from holding of birth, will require a replacement tag before the animal can leave the market, for onward movement to the slaughterhouse.

I authorise the auctioneers to act on my behalf without any responsibility attached to this action in respect of ear numbers or movement documents.

This Movement of sheep complies with all the relevant general licensing regulations as stated by the local authority. ALL sheep will need to travel with a completed AML 1 Sheep Licence with Section C – Destination Details entered as **Honiton Collection Centre**

It is the responsibility of the vendor to provide true and complete details regarding farm assurance, in the case of any Farm assurance details provided by the vendor being incomplete or incorrect the purchaser of the lot/s may at their discretion lodge a claim, in which case the vendor will be liable.

RECORDING ELECTRONIC TAGS –

We will endeavour to try and read all Electronic Sheep Ear Tags presented at the market and supply vendors with a list of all Ear Tags read (enclosed with invoice statement). Please note we are not responsible for the accuracy of the reading and recording of electronic tags and cannot be held liable for any inaccuracies. It is the **keeper's responsibility** to check that the total number of tags listed matches the total which is entered on the AML1 movement form when the sheep are sent to the market. If not, please amend your records accordingly.

FOOD CHAIN INFORMATION DECLARATION FOR CONSIGNMENTS OF ANIMALS FROM A MARKET TO A SLAUGHTERHOUSE

For each lot of sheep/goats listed on this document and for each holding from which they were consigned to the market, a declaration, signed by the keeper of the animals on each holding, has been received stating that:

- Sheep and goats on the holding are not under movement restrictions for animal disease or public health reasons (excluding a 6-day standstill).
- Withdrawal periods have been observed for all veterinary medicines and other treatments administered to the animals while on this holding and previous holdings.
- To the best of my knowledge the animals are not showing signs of any disease or condition that may affect the safety of meat derived from them.
- No analysis of samples taken from animals on the holding or other samples has shown that the animals in this consignment may have been exposed to any disease or condition that may affect the safety of meat or to substances likely to result in residues in meat.
