



KINGTON MARKET REPORT TUESDAY 2nd MARCH 2021 SALE OF STORE CATTLE

McCartneys report a fabulous store cattle sale at Kington Market for their March sale held on Tuesday 2nd March 2021. The cattle are very dear for all types, underpinned by a very good fat cattle trade and tight numbers being presented for sale.

A good entry of store cattle ranging from 12 to 22 months and 400 to 550 kg and were Charolais x, Limousin x, British Blue x and Aberdeen Angus x cattle.

The trade was excellent throughout with a very good number of buyers present eager to buy store cattle. We had excellent competition and buyers for all types of cattle achieved 100% clearance, with fabulous prices.

The well-bred and good confirmation cattle sold to premium prices and these sold up to £2.60ppk for some Charolais x steers from RT Sankey & Co

The store cattle sold to an fabulous trade right through the whole sale and a top price of £1,330 per head for some Charolais x steers from RT Sankey & Co

The store cattle prices at Kington would be as dear as anywhere if not dearer. We have plenty of space for penning and social distancing, with no waiting times and the sale conducted in a timely manner with little waiting times. Please try some cattle with us at our next sale.

March Cattle prices were as follows.

All steers averaged an excellent £2.31ppk up to £2.60k from RT Sankey & Co

The steers averaged a fabulous £1,117 per head and sold up to £1,330 from RT Sankey & Co

All heifers averaged an excellent 2.19ppk up to £2.50ppk from RT Sankey & Co

The heifers averaged an excellent £1,034 per head up to £1,190 from RT Sankey & Co

All cattle forward at the sale averaged a fabulous £1,078 per head from the smallest to the largest in the market. The majority of cattle sold from £1,000 to £1,330 per head

We had an excellent trade throughout the sale with a number of buyers forward.

We need a good entry for our April sale to meet the demand we have.

Farm assurance is important on store cattle and premiums were also being paid for those cattle which would meet the supermarket specs when finished.
