THIRD SALE IN THE MONTH OF STORE CATTLE, CALVES & SHEEP

CALVES & WEANED CALVES – 13

Top Price Bull Calf £340 – E H Pearman
Top Price Heifer Calf £305 – Tack Farms Ltd

A smaller entry of calves as expected for the third sale in the month were met with strong competition from both regular and new buyers resulting in all consigned selling to a dear trade. Some nice shaped BRBX bull calves (1 month old) from E H Pearman topped at £340 with others the same age to £315, £300 and £295. Regular consignments of well reared BRBX calves (around 1 month old) from Tack Farms saw this week's bull calves hit £305 and £300 twice. Heifers the same age from Tack Farms topped at £305 with others achieving between £300 and £275.

Another good entry to follow last week's sale of store cattle for the third sale in the month with some excellent consignments forward. Regular buyers in attendance as well as new faces around the ring to increase competition resulting in a consistently dear trade throughout.

FEEDING STEERS AVERAGED £1011 PER HEAD & 225PPK OVERALL

Continental steers in high demand with best suckler bred medium term farming steers trading between 240ppk and 275ppk. Well-bred slightly longer-term continentals generally 220ppk with dairy cross continental breeds between 215ppk and 225ppk. Younger longer term native steers traded between 230ppk and 255ppk.

Stronger forward continental steers traded between £1400 and £1120 with suckler bred forward sorts between 210ppk and 225ppk. A cracking entry of well-bred hard Angus Steers were bid to £1290 and 239ppk with others trading north of the 220ppk mark. Fleshed Hereford Steers achieved £1270 & 226ppk with other consignments regularly over £1100.

FEEDING HEIFERS AVERAGED £929 PER HEAD AND 213PPK OVERALL

Some well-bred continental heifers with younger medium term sorts trading between 255ppk and 236ppk. Younger turnout heifers around 220ppk including dairy bred continentals. Medium term suckler bred Angus traded between 220ppk and 230ppk.

Forward continental heifers between £1125 and £1020 generally between 220ppk and 230ppk. Angus X Heifers with good frames ready to gain finish up to £1115 and 244ppk with others sailing past the £1000 mark. Shorter term Hereford x heifers achieved £1010.

PRE-MOVEMENT T.B. TESTING

*As from 1st March 2007 all cattle aged 42 days and over are required to be T.B. Tested (and be negative) **within 60 days** of proposed movement if they are destined for further finishing (i.e. Store cattle at "Green Markets") provided you are in a parish of 1 or 2 years testing. If less frequent than this do not worry!*

*FINISHED CATTLE/OTM CATTLE at "Red Markets" (every Wednesday)
there is no requirement for testing*

FABBL - IMPORTANT

*Even though you are selling Store Cattle,
Buyers are very anxious that cattle **MUST BE FARM ASSURED**.
Please make every effort to get FABBL - it will be worthwhile.*

A good entry for the extra sale in the month. Possibly the edge was off slightly from last sale but, all couples still look a very good price.

North Country Mule Ewes, 4-year-old with nice single lambs at foot up to £178 or £89 a life.

Suffolk X Ewes with single lambs traded at £72.50 a life, with North Country Mule Ewes 2-4-year-old all with fairly, fresh twin lambs at foot up to £179 or £59.60 a life.
