A smaller sale common for July met a good trade. Store Steers averaged 250.75ppk selling to 269.80ppk for 430 kilo Organic Stabiliser Steer to £1160 from T Davies & Sons. Also to 266.70ppk for a Charolais 360 kilo Steer to £960 from I C Goodwin. 5 Charolais Steers from the same home weighing 385kg sold for £1030. A small selection of Steers topped at £1220 for a 490 kilo Stabiliser Steer from T Davies & Son.

Heifers averaged 233.79ppk which included some plainer sorts today. They sold to 286ppk for a Charolais Heifer weighing 430kg to £1230 from J P Breeze & Son. Also to 284.80ppk for 2 Limousin Heifers (330kg) to £940 from M J Gray & Son. Top price per head was £1385 for a 600kilo Limousin Heifer from I M & S E Goodwin.

## Shropshire Hills AONB Funding

The new DEFRA funding for 'Farming in Protected Landscapes' forms part of the Government's Agricultural Transition Plan (ATP) and is available to all farmers and landowners with land within the Shropshire Hills Area of Outstanding Natural Beauty (AONB).

The programme is aimed towards improving and benefiting climate, nature, people and place, by sequestering carbon, reducing flood risk, maintaining important habitats, enhancing flora and fauna, public engagement and preserving the historic landscape, to name but a few. Proposals can be put forward on an individual basis by farmers, to be approved by Local Assessment panels to ensure they meet the programme's objectives.

The maximum grant is £250k, with the minimum being £3k. Revenue and Capital funding is available. Where there is no apparent commercial gain, 100% of cost will be repaid, however, where commercial gain is sought 40% -80% of costs can be claimed.

Common Land is also eligible, as well as farmer cooperatives.

This programme is for one-off projects and is not an agri-environment scheme, however, it is designed to work alongside the 'Countryside Stewardship Agri-Environment' Scheme, and become part of the proposed Environment Land Management Scheme.

Applications for the first year should be made from 1<sup>st</sup> July 2021 up to 31<sup>st</sup> January 2022. It is likely, there will be two further application windows hereafter. All projects must end by March 2024.
